




2011 Loveland High School Crimson Regiment March-a-Thon Student Fact Sheet

- Who:** All Crimson Regiment Marching Band Members
- What:** The single largest fundraiser of the year. Students practice all day; Parents work the BandFair, bake sale, garage sale and hot dog stand in the adjacent parking lot. Evening performance of "The Gates" at Ray Patterson Stadium – open to the public.
- When:** Saturday, September 10, 2011
- Where:** LHS Marching Field 8-4; Ray Patterson Stadium 5:30 – 8:30 (times approximate)
- Why:** First, to raise the funds it takes to keep the LHS Band Program going; instruments; equipment; instructors; transportation to competitions; etc. Second, 20% of your collected pledges will go to your individual grant account. Third, earn fundraising letter points. 
- How:** Students seek pledges from friends, family, neighbors, etc. Pledges can be by the minute, by the hour, or a flat rate donation. Collect pledges up front – checks can be made out to LHSBB (Loveland High School Band Boosters) or payment can be made through DONATE button on the band website www.lovelandband.org. Pledge and payment method must be logged on your pledge form for tracking purposes. We will send out invoices for those who prefer to be billed, but you will only receive credit for these pledges once the payment has been received.

THE GOAL

\$250 in collected pledges from each student

Don't forget – 20% will go to your grant account!

Earn 3 letter points for every \$100 collected
